Week 1

Give thanks:

- Successful Family Fun Night after emergency relocation due to high tides.
- Opportunity to support a teenager with one to one Bible study, who doesn't have access to anything similar at home. (Pray too for following up throughout the year)
- Chances to encourage holidaying Christian families through our witness

Pray for:

- Family who have come to everything for the last 3 years. Children are growing in their knowledge of the Bible. Mum has been listening and considering over the years. Pray she'd take the step of finding a good local church.

- Couple with teenage daughter who rarely join in but sit close by to listen in. Dad sceptical but happy to listen. Mum, catholic, took 321 to read after KO.
- Mum and child who joined for treasure hunt and came back for FFN. Grew up in a church but pray she'd come to faith herself.
- Day visitors who asked 'where is God in a messed up world' and were given the corresponding book!
- Grandad who lost his faith after his grandson died. Pray that he would see God's love in his grief.

Week 2

Give thanks:

- Storm Lilian washed up new sand to provide enough beach for a spring high tide morning programme.
- Divine appointments for just the right team members to speak into peoples situations
- Energy for team members at the end of season, who had done several weeks missions this summer
- A people-centred approach to the teams' outreach

Pray for:

- An extended family of three generations with 5 children, local to Scarborough. Grandparents gradually opened up for the children to have bible studies and continuing follow up.
- Two local teenage girls reconnected with the team after a tough year – and taking more of a personal interest in the team and our message.
- An extended family, with several young children who insisted they come to the Beach Team every time. They have some religious background, and very enthusiastic, but generally not clear on Jesus' salvation.
- A lady who was emotionally moved when hearing a team member's testimony and wanting to find out more and hopefully start going to church

The Beach Mission team completed 2 weeks of activities on North Bay on Friday 30th August.
