Notice to Members

Election of Trustees to the CIO at the AGM on 17th April 2024



The CIO Constitution requires that all the first Trustees named in the Constitution stand down at its first AGM, so we are asking Members to nominate people to fill the vacancies.

The Minister is automatically a Trustee as long as he is in office. In addition we need a minimum of 5 and up to 12 Trustees. As Anna Welford was elected as a Trustee in the CIO, she does not need to stand down, and will serve for 3 years, so there are up to 11 vacancies.

The roles to be filled are: Church Secretary, Treasurer, Elders and Deacons.

The Church Secretary and Treasurer are elected annually, the Deacons for a period of 3 years and the Elders for 5 years; however, at this election, we will try to ensure that one third of the Trustees retire each year, so we propose that we appoint deacons for 1, 2 and 3 years and Elders for 2 and 5 years.

Of the existing Trustees, the following are willing to re-stand if nominated:

John Games (Elder) 2 years; Paul Smith (Elder) 5 years; Jane Taylor (Deacon) 2 years; Janet Wilson (Deacon) 1 year; Bill Holmes (Secretary); Phillip Gott (Treasurer).

We would also like to recruit at least one more deacon.

Please would all members be asking the Lord who you should approach to serve in these roles. Nominees must be at least 18 years of age.

Nomination forms are available in church. These need to be signed by the nominee and two members and returned to the Church Secretary **by 31st March 2024 at the latest.**
