Harps, strings and life

John Payne says:

During Jim's sermon last Sunday, he referred to harps. Having made a few harps myself, I felt God speaking to me. We are like the harp, an instrument that is sensitive to its environment, and needs 'weather tuning' when there are changes in temperature and humidity. Like the harp, you and I are instruments in God's hands. At times we need some adjustment, 'weather tuning' or other, but God can still use us or speak to us as we are. I felt the main point is that it doesn't matter how *beautiful* the harp is, unless it is played, its beauty is unappreciated. God wants us to be appreciated by Him, and by others. He is wanting to talk to us as He plays our strings. I have never heard a harp sound bad: even when out of tune, a beautiful sound can come out. If you are worried that you might not be finely tuned or even completely out of tune, you take one step at a time. God can change the ears of the listener. As you hear God speak, take a step of faith and act on it: He will lead you.




