Being available – Acts 8:26-40

Sometimes we make excuses. Sometimes we dare to create opportunities. The difference is being available.

Willing to be interupted (26)

Philip had a successful ministry (8:5-9) but was willing to be interupted by the Holy Spirit. He was willing to do something that challenged logic – go somewhere that didn't make sense.

Willing to engage (27-30)

At every level, the Ethiopian Eunuch was so different to Philip... but that was not a barrier to engaging with him. We "Go!" to all people.

Willing to explain (31-34)

Philip begins with the Ethiopean's question (not what you would expect). When God sets up divine appointments it is with humble, teachable hearts. We need to begin with what is on their hearts.

Willing to proclaim (35-38)

Philip explains the Good News of Jesus and we know this proclamation has been received for the man asks for baptism. Philip is confident that his heart is for Jesus and baptizes him.

Willing to move on (39-40)

Philip does not dwell in the comfort and joy of the victory but is moved on. This challenges us to see if we are keeping in step with the Holy Spirit.

- O What one thing did we take away from the service this week?
- What are we going to do differently as a result of what we have heard?
- How do we know if we are truly available to God? What might be getting in the way?
- What are the different ways you might tell someone the Good News of Jesus? How
 do we understand where people are at, and speak to them where they are? Is it
 important to encourage people to be baptized?
- What might cause us to get stuck? What do we need to get us going?
